Required Procedures for Kindergarten/1st and 2nd grade Kanawha County School Bus Identification Safety Tag Program:

- 1) The Pupil Transportation Department will provide a supply of Kanawha County School Bus Identification Safety Tag Program Forms to each elementary school.
- 2) A parent (guardian) of each Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd Grade student shall complete a Kanawha County School Identification Safety Tag Program Form indicating a choice to participate (Option A) or not participate (Option B) in the program.
- 3) Teachers must complete their section, make a copy for their files and return the original to the Pupil Transportation Department at Crede.
- 4) The Pupil Transportation Department will provide the following to the school:
 - a. A lanyard (neck strap) and identification safety tag for each participating student
 - b. Three (3) additional identification safety tags for authorized persons to show the bus driver at the door of the bus at the established bus stop.
 - c. Two (2) additional <u>red</u> identification safety tags per participating student for teachers to have in case an identification safety tag is lost, or left at home.
 - d. Three (3) extra lanyards (neck straps) per classroom.
- 5) Each participating student must wear an identification safety tag properly displayed on the outside of their clothing while in transit, both A.M. and P.M.
- 6) Everyday, teachers and/or aides must assure participating transported students have their identification safety tags properly displayed on the outside of their clothing and are escorted to their respective school bus for their afternoon bus ride home.
- 7) An authorized person must be present at the established bus stop, show the bus operator the appropriate matching identification safety tag, and receive the child at the door of the bus.
- 8) If a participating student does not have their identification safety tag, teachers shall provide a <u>red</u> safety tag to be worn on the bus ride home. The child is expected to wear both the yellow and <u>red</u> safety tags to school the next morning. The student will return the <u>red</u> tag to the teacher.
- On those infrequent occasions when an immediate emergency occurs preventing the authorized person to be present at the bus stop, the participating student will be taken back to the school or to the school bus terminal. School bus drivers will, as soon as possible, communicate with the bus terminal so that the school and/or parent can be informed promptly.
- 10) Parents must explain the identification safety tag program to day care centers which are utilized before and after school. A day care center employee must show the appropriate matching identification safety tag to the bus driver at the door of the bus.

11) A Kindergarten, 1st or 2nd grade student's parent (guardian) may opt in or out of the program by completing a new Kanawha County School Bus Safety Tag Form.

It is anticipated that all elementary principals, kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade teachers, bus operators, parents, and students will thoroughly understand the proper procedures. Your prompt attention and support is requested to help make this Safety Tag Program a continued success.

In any practice, there are occasions where punitive procedures may become necessary for employees as well as students or parents. When a child must have safety tags remade be brought back to school or taken to the bus terminal in order to wait for parental pick up, the following action will be taken:

<u>1st Violation</u> - <u>WARNING</u> - The bus driver will fill out a "Safety Tag Program Violation Report" (copy attached) and give a copy to the school principal and bus terminal supervisor. The school is required to notify the parent, complete the report and follow the procedures on the report.

<u>2nd Violation</u> - The student loses bus privileges for one week...document with second "Violation Report" given to the school principal and terminal supervisor. School notifies parent to provide transportation and also lets the bus driver know the start date and end date of the bus transportation suspension.

<u>3rd Violation</u> - The bus driver will fill out the third "Violation Report" and give a copy to both the school principal and the terminal supervisor. Parent will be notified by the school that their **child** is no longer eligible to participate in the identification safety tag program and will be denied transportation privileges for the remainder of the school year.

In order for a child to be allowed transportation privileges, the parent must sign another bus tag form opting out of the "Bus Identification Safety Tag Program". The student will not be allowed to opt back into the program to circumvent punitive action created by 2nd and/or 3rd violations as stated above.

Each parent of transported Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade students must complete their portion of the Kanawha County School Bus Identification Safety Tag Form and return it to the appropriate teacher. Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade teachers must maintain a copy of this form and provide the Transportation Department with the original. The Pupil Transportation Department will make sure the correct bus terminal supervisor receives a copy of all forms. The terminal supervisor must provide the appropriate bus driver(s) a copy of the form.

It takes a team effort on the part of each kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade student, parent, teacher, principal, supervisor and bus driver to make sure each child is transported safely, while not compromising security.
